How Will Projects Be Judged?

Criteria	What We’re Looking For
Creativity	We value innovative, unique, and original ideas that stand out from the crowd. Your project should demonstrate out-of-the-box thinking and offer fresh approaches to sustainability and environmental challenges.
Relevance to Theme	Ensure your project has a clear and strong connection to the theme "Eco-Vision 2030." Focus on how your idea contributes to creating a sustainable, eco-friendly future and aligns with the goals of environmental responsibility.
Feasibility	Your idea should be practical and achievable within the context of our school. Consider available resources, time, and budget to ensure your project can realistically be implemented.
Presentation	A well-organized, clear, and engaging presentation is essential. Use visuals, diagrams, or multimedia to enhance your work and make it compelling. Your message should be easy to understand and impactful.
Impact	Show the potential for your project to create meaningful change. Consider how your idea could improve sustainability in our school, influence your peers, and inspire others to take action toward an eco-friendly future.
